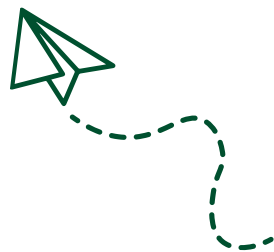

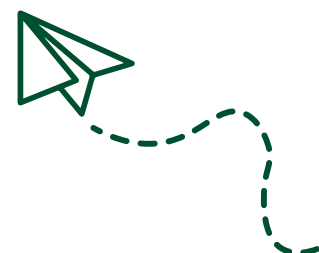
8. As a Powiślański University, we are proud to inform you about the successes of our foreign partners

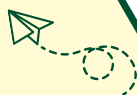
