# MEDICAL CARE

## HOW TO GET MEDICAL HELP?

Students from non – EU/EEA countries can sign-up for health insurance from the NFZ\*, the Polish government health insurance agency.

**The sign-up process requires some paperwork and patience.**

The main steps are:

- gather your documents
- sign-up at the NFZ office
- register your account at ZUS\*\* office
- make your first payment (at a post office or your bank)
- pick-up your insurance booklet (and EHIC if you want it) at the NFZ office
