D. BACKGROUND AND EXPERIENCE

Powiślański University started its activity in 1999 as a non-public university registered under number 166 in the Register of Non-Public Higher Education Institutions. Currently, the University provides education on full-time and part-time studies with a practical profile in the following fields of study: Nursing (undergraduate and graduate studies), Emergency Medicine (undergraduate studies), Dietetics (undergraduate studies), Cosmetology (undergraduate studies), Economics (undergraduate studies). For many years the PSW is currently implementing the projects: "Higher qualifications guarantee professional success - specialist and qualification courses for Nurses" (PLN 2.9 million), "Powiślański Monoprofile Medical Simulation Centre (PLN 2.5 million), "Together for the Development of Nursing" (PLN 6.2 million), "Integrated University", "Accessible and Barrier Free Powiślański University" and "Pomeranian Cooperation Zone for BPO Development".

Powiślański University's international cooperation include over 225 signed IIA in the framework of Erasmus+ programme in 62 countries.

E. Activities and experience in the areas relevant for this project.

Powiślański University since 2017 is involved as one of the first universities in Poland in the working group of Social Responsibility of Universities, which conducts research for staff and students and publishes the Workbooks of Good Practices to be implemented by Polish universities. In 2020, the university has approved the new Strategic Plan for Development for years 2021-2027 to optimize as well as increase university contribution to the society and research locally and globally. The transformation of the university included opening of 3 new campuses:

1. Campus in Gdańsk – inauguration in academic year 2021/2022
2. Campus in Kościerzyna - inauguration in academic year 2022/2023
3. Campus in Toruń - inauguration in academic year 2022/2023

which PSW successfully implemented in those years to provide students with practical education in the field of Nursing. This way the university created a cross-linked community with more than 60 partner hospitals in the Northern Poland to

improve the country's situation with shortage of medical staff. Referring to the Strategic Development Plan of PSW, the university, in May, 2021 has finished the creation of Center of Medical Simulation, which is the most robotized and automatized center to provide practical education for nursing, midwifery and emergency medicine students on the highest level of quality. Another implemented action was the creation of Institute of Science and Development, which currently publishes academic publications. The biggest success of the Institute is creation and registration of Powiślański Publishing House in 2023.

In terms of social and environmental responsibility of the university, we have successfully appointed the Rector's Representative for social and environmental responsibility of the Powiślański University, which is currently undergoing the analysis to create plan to move in the direction of more sustainable university.
