**REGULATIONS ON THE ORGANIZATION OF THE DIPLOMA EXAMINATION
IN THE NURSING FIRST-CYCLE STUDIES PROGRAM
AT POWIŚLAŃSKI UNIVERSITY**

Legal basis of the regulations:

The study program in Nursing implemented at the Faculty of Health Sciences complies with the following:

I. General Provisions

§ 1

1. Completion of studies in the field of Nursing occurs after passing the final examination with a grade of at least satisfactory.
2. The purpose of the final examination is to determine the level of mastery by the student of professional skills in the scope defined by the educational standard and the professional competencies resulting from the Regulation of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of July 26, 2019, on the standards for education preparing for the profession of a doctor, dentist, pharmacist, nurse, midwife, laboratory diagnostician, physiotherapist, and paramedic.
3. The final examination takes place on the dates determined by the Vice-Rector for Teaching.

§ 2

1. The conditions for admission to the final examination are:
 - 1) obtaining approval for all subjects and passing all exams as provided in the study program;
 - 2) receiving a positive evaluation from the supervisor and the reviewer of the bachelor thesis;
 - 3) completing all practical classes and professional internships covered by the program.
2. The final examination consists of:
 - 1) an examination on professional preparation – a theoretical exam and a practical exam;
 - 2) the defense of the bachelor thesis.
3. Each part of the final examination is subject to separate, independent evaluation criteria.
4. A positive final result is obtained only by the student who receives a positive grade in each part of the final examination, determined according to the grading scale in force at the University (Annex No. 1 and 1A).

§ 3

1. The final examination is conducted by the Examination Board, hereinafter referred to as "the Board," appointed by the Vice-Rector for Teaching.
2. The Board must consist of at least three members, including the chairperson and members. In justified cases, the chairperson may appoint a deputy.

II. Examination on Professional Preparation

§ 4

1. The examination on professional preparation – the theoretical exam and the practical exam – takes place no later than one day before the defense of the bachelor thesis.
2. Passing the examination on professional preparation with a grade of at least satisfactory is a condition for admitting the student to the defense of the bachelor thesis.
3. During the professional preparation exam, the commission evaluates the student's mastery of learning outcomes in the areas of knowledge, skills, and social competencies in accordance with the study program for the Nursing program.

§ 5

1. The Examination Committee for the professional preparation exam consists of:
 - 1) the chairperson,
 - 2) members – individuals with a relevant professional qualification.
2. The chairperson of the committee:
 - 1) approves the examination tasks for the theoretical and practical parts of the exam,
 - 2) supervises the proper conduct of the exam,
 - 3) resolves any disputes arising during the exam,
 - 4) announces the exam results.
3. The committee members:
 - 1) prepare the examination tasks for the theoretical and practical parts of the professional preparation exam,
 - 2) evaluate the execution of the exam tasks and the candidate's knowledge and skills using established evaluation criteria.

§ 6

1. Separate scoring is established for the theoretical and practical parts of the professional preparation exam.
2. A student may earn a maximum of 100 points for each part (theoretical and practical), with a minimum of 61 points in the theoretical part and 51 points in the practical part.
3. After both parts of the exam are completed, the committee determines the result of the professional preparation exam.

II A. Professional Preparation Exam – Theoretical Exam

§ 7

1. The theoretical exam consists of solving a test containing exam questions/tasks related to nursing.
2. The exam questions/tasks are prepared by the committee members based on the approved study program.
3. Each question/task is worth 1 point, and the maximum number of points a student can earn from the test is 100.
4. The theoretical exam is considered passed if the student earns at least 61 points out of 100, i.e., a grade of at least satisfactory.

5. The documentation of the theoretical exam consists of a protocol (Annex No. 2) with the attached answer sheet for the exam questions.

II B. Professional Preparation Exam – Practical Exam

§ 8

1. The practical exam aims to assess the student's practical preparation for the nursing profession.
2. The practical exam for professional preparation, which concludes the first-cycle nursing studies, is conducted in a healthcare facility and consists of performing an exam task of the "Work Trial" type.
3. The practical exam concluding the first-cycle studies for licensed nurses is conducted in accordance with the law and involves the student solving an exam task of the "Case Study" type – presenting a practical solution to a patient's health problem.
4. The practical exam referred to in paragraph 3 must be documented in the protocol for the practical exam in professional preparation for first-cycle nursing studies for licensed nurses (Annex No. 4).

§ 9

1. The "Work Trial" type practical exam is conducted in a healthcare facility designated by the Vice-Rector for Teaching, particularly in departments such as internal medicine, surgery, and pediatrics.
2. During the practical exam, a representative of the healthcare facility – a head nurse, department nurse, or another authorized nurse from the department – may participate in the committee's work as an observer.
3. During the practical exam, several evaluation committees may work simultaneously. One committee member can supervise a maximum of three students.
4. The department where the practical exam will take place is drawn by lot in the presence of the Committee on the day the theoretical exam is successfully passed. If fewer than six students are taking the defense, the drawing is not conducted – in this case, the department is designated by the Vice-Rector for Teaching.
5. A protocol is drawn up for the drawing of departments for the practical exam, signed by the chairperson and members of the Committee (Annex No. 5).
6. The practical exam in one department can be conducted simultaneously for a maximum of 12 students. In this case, the exam is conducted in two shifts: the first group takes the exam at 6:00 AM, and the second group at 2:00 PM. The practical exam lasts one duty shift (360 minutes, 8 hours of teaching time).
7. The exam begins at the time set by the committee, with a drawing of the "Work Trial" exam task, which requires the student to apply practical professional skills and justify the chosen solution. The professional tasks are performed without simulation, at fully equipped workstations.
8. During the practical exam, the student will provide nursing care to one patient.
9. The task sheet for the student should contain:
 - 1) the patient's initials, age, medical diagnosis, and room number;
 - 2) instructions for performing the exam task/issues to be solved by the student (Annex No. 6).

10. The exam task must include:
 - 1) the written consent of the patient to participate in the exam (Annex No. 7),
 - 2) a sample of patient care documentation and criteria for observing and evaluating the student's performance by the Committee (Annexes No. 8 and 9).
11. The exam task consists of:
 - 1) providing nursing care to the patient (time of execution: 315 minutes, 6 teaching hours),
 - 2) submitting an individual oral and written report on the nursing process during the last hour of the exam.
12. The student may use the patient and department documentation to the extent necessary to complete the exam task. It is not permissible to seek assistance from other individuals or sources.
13. A mistake made by the student during the execution of the exam task that endangers the health or life of the patient is considered a failure of the practical exam.
14. During the practical exam, the student is required to comply with the internal regulations of the department, data protection regulations, and patient rights, as well as possess an up-to-date health booklet, adhere to health and safety regulations, and follow HIV and hepatitis B and C prevention guidelines.
15. The student may not leave the department on their own during the exam. If it is necessary for the student to leave the department in relation to patient care, a member of the Committee must accompany them.

§ 10

1. During the practical exam, the Committee evaluates the student's work and the performance of the "Work Trial" exam task according to the following criteria:
 - 1) patient and personal safety, creating conditions for the patient to receive care;
 - 2) level of task completion in relation to the standard;
 - 3) independence in decision-making, efficiency, and appropriateness of actions;
 - 4) ability to communicate and collaborate within the therapeutic team and with the patient;
 - 5) correctness of documenting the nursing process;
 - 6) self-assessment of the student's actions.
2. The student should be familiar with the evaluation criteria before starting the exam.
3. Committee members collect information about the examinee in the observation and evaluation sheet for the "Work Trial" exam task (Annex No. 9).
4. The minimum requirement to pass the practical exam is to obtain at least 51 points out of 100 possible, corresponding to at least a satisfactory grade.
5. The Committee prepares a protocol of the practical exam (Annex No. 10), which includes the exam task and the patient care documentation kept by the student during the exam.

II C. Result of the Professional Preparation Exam

§ 11

1. After the completion of both parts of the exam, the Committee determines the final result of the professional preparation exam.
2. The result of the professional preparation exam is the arithmetic mean of the grades obtained from the theoretical and practical exams.
3. The student has passed the professional preparation exam if, as a result of the examination procedure, they have obtained at least a satisfactory grade.

4. Obtaining a failing grade in the professional preparation exam is equivalent to being disqualified from the bachelor's thesis defense and receiving a failing grade for the diploma exam.
5. The results of the professional preparation exam are documented by the Committee in the protocols of the conducted examination procedure: individual (Annex No. 11) and collective (Annex No. 12).

III. Defense of the Bachelor's Thesis

§ 12

1. The completed and supervisor-approved diploma thesis is one of the conditions for allowing the student to take the diploma exam.
2. The diploma thesis, before submission, is subject to an anti-plagiarism procedure as specified by a separate Rector's decree.
3. The completed diploma thesis, i.e., the one approved by the supervisor and subjected to the anti-plagiarism procedure referred to in § 12 of the Regulations for the Organization of the Diploma Exam for the Nursing Bachelor's Program, must be submitted electronically in PDF format to the following email addresses (depending on the location):

along with the statement referred to in § 12, Section 4 of the Regulations for the Organization of the Diploma Exam for the Nursing Bachelor's Program / statements (required under separate regulations).
4. The statement referred to in Section 3, the template of which is Annex No. 3 to the Regulations for the Organization of the Diploma Exam for the Nursing Bachelor's Program, must be signed electronically by the student using the ePUAP trusted profile. The signed document, saved in PDF format, must be sent by the student along with the diploma thesis as referred to in Section 4 of § 12 of the Regulations, to the email address (depending on the location):

5. The student must label the diploma thesis and statement(s) with their first and last name and student ID number.
6. The Vice-Rector for Teaching, upon the request of the thesis supervisor or the student, may extend the deadline for submitting the diploma thesis in the case of:
 - a) a long-term illness of the student, confirmed by a relevant medical certificate;
 - b) an inability to complete the diploma thesis within the required deadline due to justified reasons.
7. The deadline for submitting the thesis in these cases may be extended by no more than three months from the date set by the Vice-Rector for Teaching.
8. The defense of the bachelor's thesis takes place before a Committee consisting of:
 - 1) Chairperson – Vice-Rector for Teaching or a person appointed by them;
 - 2) Members – Thesis supervisor and reviewer of the thesis (in exceptional cases, a person or persons designated by the Vice-Rector for Teaching).

9. During the defense of the thesis, the student answers questions related to the thesis topic and, possibly, additional questions posed by the Committee members.
10. After assessing the answers provided, the Committee determines the final grade for the thesis defense. The condition for passing the thesis defense is obtaining a positive grade.
11. The result of the thesis defense, taking into account the grade given by the supervisor and reviewer, is documented by the Committee in a protocol (Annex No. 13).
12. The documentation of the thesis defense, including the evaluation card for the thesis (Annex No. 14) and the protocol from the defense, is an integral part of the documentation for the professional preparation exam.

IV. Final Result of the Diploma Exam and Final Result of Studies

§ 13

After the completion of the exam, the Committee determines the final result of the diploma exam, taking into account the result of the professional preparation exam and the thesis defense, in accordance with § 2, Section 4.

§ 14

1. The Committee determines the final result of the studies according to the principle established in the study regulations, where the result is the sum of:
 1. $\frac{1}{2}$ of the arithmetic mean of grades from the course of studies,
 2. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the arithmetic mean of the grade for the diploma thesis,
 3. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the grade from the diploma exam.
2. The final result of the studies is documented in the program protocol (Annex No. 13).
3. The documentation of the diploma exam is stored in the University's records according to the principles set out in separate regulations.

§ 15

After completing the studies in the field of nursing, the student obtains the title of Bachelor of Nursing.

V. Final Provisions

§ 16

1. A student who, due to unforeseen circumstances, did not attend the diploma exam, interrupted the exam, or did not pass the exam in the first term, may take the exam again according to the separate regulations specified in the Study Regulations.
2. If a student receives a failing grade in the thesis defense but a passing grade in the professional preparation exam, in the second exam term, the student retains the passing grade from the professional preparation exam and only attends the thesis defense.

§ 17

1. There is no appeal against the grade determined in accordance with the provisions of this regulation.

2. A student has the right to appeal any decision made by the Vice-Rector for Teaching to the Rector.

§ 18

This Regulation for the Organization of the Diploma Exam enters into force on the day it is adopted.
