Powiślański University was established in 1999 as a non-state HEI, registered under number 166 in the Register of Non-Public Higher Education Institutions (formerly: Register of Non-Public Higher Education Institutions and Associations of Non-Public Higher Education Institutions), kept by the Minister of Science and Higher Education.

Powiślański University is a non-profit organization. Its founder is the Society for Economic and Environmental Education in Kwidzyn, represented by people who are professionally involved in various forms of education and whose passion is the continuous improvement of educational methods and results. Reliable education of students is a priority for us, therefore we take special care when selecting lecturers, taking into account their knowledge, qualifications, experience and skills.

Powiślański University, constantly facing the changing market realities, including the widely understood labour market, is realizing its main vision „CHOOSE THE PROFESSION OF TOMORROW!“ and of course constantly improving the quality of education, focuses on development. Development in the sense of constantly expanding educational offer, corresponding to the needs of regional and local employers, with whom it cooperates on an ongoing basis within the Powiślański University Employers Council, but also development in the context of improving and modernizing didactic and research-didactic base. In this regard, the University has launched the Powiślański Monoprofile Center of Medical Simulations for the Faculty of Health Sciences, which has a number of specialized laboratories, computer laboratories, including those with full facilities for disabled students.

However, to meet the needs of students, listening to their voices very carefully, because „WE ARE FOR THE STUDENT“ - in our performance is not an advertising slogan, but real actions, the University implements a number of educational, but also developmental projects, in the context of developing branches of the University, so as to facilitate studying. Thus, it is implementing territorial expansion - branches in Gdansk, Torun and Koscierzyna are in the country, it is also trying to establish branches abroad and also new educational programs.



The student's education and their practical skills are a priority for the University, therefore we take special care in selecting the research and teaching staff taking into account their knowledge, qualifications, experience and skills.

At our University, the high level of classes is guaranteed by 122 teaching staff members, including 5 professors, 44 doctors, 73 master's degree holders. The staff of Powiślański University consists of high-class specialists with established scientific authority and rich practical knowledge. They are persons with significant scientific achievements, recognized in the country and abroad.

The basis for staff selection is a positive assessment of the compatibility of the teaching, research and teaching profile with the field and discipline of science, and thus with the directions of education at PSW. The staff is also based on experienced PRACTITIONERS, specialists in their fields, including high-level managers from the field of ECONOMY, chief nurses and directors of nursing from leading units of the health care system in the region for the specialization in NURSING, heads of emergency wards and specialized paramedics in the field of EMERGENCY MEDICINE, professionally active recognized specialists in the field of COSMETOLOGY and DIETETICS, respected and valued midwives for the specialization in MIDWIFERY, and other practitioners with extensive professional experience, confirmed by successes, whose professional careers clearly demonstrate the knowledge they possess.



Institute of Science and Development

For the purpose of staff development, the University has established the Institute of Science and Development

The Institute organizes, supports and supervises the process of obtaining scientific titles for teaching and research staff of the University. The mission of the Institute is to support the education of its own research and development staff by means of obtaining doctoral, post-doctoral and professorial titles by teachers. The Institute, taking advantage of the huge scientific potential and professional experience of its academic staff, is tasked with undertaking research and development projects whose effects and outcomes will have a beneficial and effective impact on the socio-economic environment. The Institute also plays the role of an expert and advisory body for external entities interested in obtaining professional substantive and opinion-forming help with regard to problems encountered in the functioning of enterprises or institutions, and questionable issues in the field of economy and health care. 



We know that many of our students work, have families, responsibilities or absorbing hobbies. That is why we design our curricula and study plans in a way that guarantees not only acquiring the necessary knowledge and skills, but also makes it possible to reconcile studies with private life.

Theoretical education

Theoretical education at Powiślański University is based on modern and constantly upgraded didactic base, including specialist laboratories for nursing / paramedics / cosmetology / dietetics / midwifery, criminology, as well as computer laboratories for economics / IT and specialist rooms for psychology. For the purposes of didactics at the Faculty of Health Sciences, the Powiślański Monoprofile Center of Medical Simulations was also established. The following forms of education are implemented in the various fields of study:

- Lectures
- Classes
- Seminars
- Classes without participation of an academic teacher (BUNA) - self-study
- Practical classes
- Professional practice
- E-learning / remote classes



For the purposes of theoretical education - mainly lectures, the Powiślański University's Distance Learning Platform is used. E-learning is a form of supplementing the knowledge by the students. For this purpose, Powiślański University uses the Moodle educational platform, which is directly connected to the Virtual Dean's Office, i.e. the university's student service system and the PSW Remote Learning Platform based on the MSTEams365 streaming platform. This is a convenient way to support traditional forms of education. The advantage of remote classes is the possibility to learn outside the traditional didactic base. Students can access materials at any time and place. E-learning enables the demand for self-study, but it also supports students, as part of long life learning. This form of education also provides greater efficiency due to the attractiveness of the information contained in the training. It can be presentations, visualizations, quizzes, tests and other resources that the lecturer wants to provide to his students.

Practical classes

When organizing practical classes and student internships, we are guided by the principle that the internship must help the student prepare to work in the job market, so that he or she has adequate experience, can determine their place in the competitive job market, and help choose their own path of development. Currently, more than 100 major employers cooperate with the University.

The primary objective of practical training is to systematize and consolidate the knowledge acquired during the didactic classes at the University and to achieve the assumed learning outcomes in terms of knowledge, skills and social competence. During practical training, the student participates in the current work at the chosen employer and masters the required practical skills, which are acquired under the supervision and guidance of the Supervisor of Practical Training. The student shall be required to complete and pass with a passing grade the required knowledge, practical skills and social competences. The course of practical training is documented and monitored on an ongoing basis.

DOUBLE DIPLOMA Program at Powiślański University

It allows to obtain a diploma in one field of study at two universities simultaneously.

The classes are conducted in English by suitably qualified teaching staff.

A prerequisite for the award of the double degree is the completion of required courses at the home institution and at the partner institution as well as the preparation of one undergraduate dissertation, defended at both institutions.

The Double Diploma Programme guarantees the acquisition of new skills in an international environment and enables to increase competitiveness on the job market. Moreover, it ensures the development of cultural cooperation, promotion of student mobility and exchange of ideas and professional experience.



Professional Training

The University provides internships in a variety of institutions and enterprises in accordance with the chosen field of study, e.g. for the nursing major in medical institutions of primary health care, in-patient treatment and specialized departments, as well as in teaching and educational institutions. The selection of institutions for the realization of practical training is based on criteria determined by the University, taking into account the achievement of learning outcomes.

Practical vocational training organized outside the structure of the University takes place on the basis of an agreement concluded between the University and the entity providing practical training. Practical classes are realized by students according to their own preferences - in terms of location and date of realization. Professional practice may be carried out by the student at the time and place indicated by him.



The above forms allow to achieve the learning outcomes in the field of knowledge, skills and social competence and are a guarantee that the student will achieve the assumed graduate profile.

Powiślański University undertakes a number of actions to enable as many people as possible to study. The scholarship system, among others, serves this purpose. Students who are in a difficult financial situation receive **social scholarships, financial aid, and students who achieve high results in their studies, in sports and artistically talented - Rector's scholarship.**

Special privileges are directed towards disabled persons.

Social grant and scholarship for disabled students are granted for the whole period of studies, also in the first year, whereas scholarship for learning or sporting achievements is granted from the second year of studies.

During the last academic year the University Scholarship Committee had about PLN 620,000 at its disposal. It should be emphasized that each student who met the formal requirements benefited from the scholarship. The average monthly amount of the Rector's scholarship is about PLN 550, social scholarship and scholarship for disabled students is PLN 520. The University also grants one-time support in case of random events in the amount of up to PLN 5,000.

The aim of the Declaration is to build broad social awareness of the role of HEIs in creating conditions for sustainable socio-economic development of the country.



„Human Resources + Design” project.

Improving the competences of PSW teaching staff in the field of universal design.

The main objective of the project is to organize specialized training courses, workshops, as well as study visits preparing to conduct Universal Design classes.

Pilot classes of Universal Design, will be implemented by staff teaching staff trained as part of the project and will be based on the document entitled Modules of Universal Design classes within selected educational areas and will be implemented within the framework of the project in first- and second-level studies in the following majors:

- Economics,
- Emergency Medicine,
- Nursing - first and second degree studies,
- Midwifery.

Ongoing use of the acquired competencies will contribute to the consolidation of new skills and will translate into higher quality of didactics at PSW. Implementation of classes based on the developed model solutions will contribute to maintaining high standard of education at Powiślański University.



The project Accessible and Barrier-Free Powiślański University

The aim of the project is to support organizational changes and to raise awareness and competence of the university staff - Powiślański University - in the field of disability through implementation of activities aimed at ensuring accessibility of the university in terms of communication, administered websites, IT tools, educational procedures in higher education, introduction of modifications to educational programs to ensure their accessibility for students with disabilities and activities in the field of architectural accessibility.

As part of the project, the following tasks will be implemented:

- Elimination of architectural barriers
- Eliminating communication barriers
- Improving the competences of university staff (administrative, management and teaching staff)
- Equipping teaching laboratories, adaptation of teaching materials to the needs of people with disabilities.

Integrated University Project

Project activities are addressed to students of medical faculties (emergency medicine and nursing) and economics, who will receive dedicated support to improve their general, professional, linguistic, analytical and IT competencies within the competence enhancement module, and to acquire practical skills in the course of implementation of internship tasks within the internship program module.

Within the project we offer the opportunity to participate free of charge in courses implemented as a series of training courses on improving interpersonal skills.

The training will be complemented by interdisciplinary practical classes and additional classes organized with employers to better prepare graduates to enter the labor market, aimed at validating the acquired skills in practice.

Project Pomeranian Cooperation Zone for Development of BPO

The aim of the project is to develop human resources for the business services sector (e.g. BPO, SSC, IT) by improving competences of students of the Powiślański University (practical profile studies)

Support in the project will be implemented, at each stage, in cooperation with employers from the Modern Business Services sector.


